Safer Roads and Overall Safety in the Community Rule.”

- Indian Field at Hardyston has a posted speed limit of 25 mph on Forest Hill Way.
- All other roads have a posted speed limit of 15 mph.
- Any vehicle captured on camera between the speed of 31 - 35 will first get a warning letter. Ten warning letters will result in a fine of \$25.00 per further incident.
- Any vehicle captured on camera going over 35mph will get an automatic fine of \$25.00 no warning letter.
- All further similar violations: \$25.00 fine per incident.
- Any vehicle captured on camera at 50mph and over –The vehicle will be reported to the Hardyston Police – “disregard for the safety of the residents.”
- Vehicles captured on camera, that are not registered in the community, or not resident vehicles will be pursued further to the full extent of the law with all Municipal Authorities.
- All homeowners are to fill out completely, and submit their census form to management, which is to include all info on all vehicles owned.
- Failure to submit the mandatory census form by June 1st will result in a loss of all community privileges.
- An Indian Field Static ID Sticker will be provided for all vehicles registered with the community and must be displayed.
- Static stickers are to be placed where visible, either in the front upper right-hand side of the front windshield, or the driver’s side rear quarter window, or the on the lower left side of the rear windshield.
- Guest vehicles are to have an Indian Field Guest tag hanging on the rearview mirror. One guest tag will be supplied per household upon receipt of the census form.
- This rule will be mandatory to all.
